



REQUIREMENTS FOR PLAYERS DISPLAYING HANDICAP FLAGS

The use of a handicap flag is a privilege and Harbor Hills Country Club would appreciate you adhering to the following requirements.

The locations of the BLUE STAKES were selected by a group consisting of the golf pro, course superintendent, and some HHMGA members currently using the Handicap Flag Privilege.

1. No cartwheels on the surface of the greens, the fringe/collar, tee boxes or trap lips.
2. Never drive or park within 30 feet of the greens unless pulling directly up to a BLUE STAKE.
3. Do not drive/park between a BLUE STAKE and a green, sand trap, or the collar of green.
4. Do not move a BLUE STAKE unless it is necessary to play your shot.
5. Stay on the cart path with all 4 wheels as much as possible.
6. Try to approach the BLUE STAKE from the direction doing the least damage to the approach areas. If the BLUE STAKE you choose is at the rear of the green, please approach it from the rear.
7. When departing, back out the way you came in when feasible.

USING THE BEST APPROACH TO AND DEPARTURE FROM BLUE STAKES MAY REQUIRE DRIVING A LITTLE OUT OF YOUR WAY AND TAKE A LITTLE EXTRA TIME BUT PLEASE TAKE THAT TIME.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WILL RESULT IN A WARNING, FURTHER FAILURE TO COMPLY COULD RESULT IN SUSPENSION FROM PLAYING IN THE WEEKLY GROUPS AND MGA DAYS.
